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The appropriate Clinical/Experiential Education Director/Associate/Assistant Director and the clinicians/administrators of an experiential education site have the authority to remove students from the site if their performance or behavior compromise patient safety or is disruptive to staff and/or site operations. Any student whose competence and/or attitudes and behaviors are sufficiently deficient or inappropriate as to warrant removal from an experiential education site prior to the completion of the educational experience will receive a failing (F) or unsatisfactory (UN) grade for that experience.

Required courses in which grades of F or UN are earned must be repeated at the student's expense in order to graduate. Students earning two grades of F or UN will be dismissed in accordance with the School's Scholastic Standing Policy.

Students are urged to contact their Clinical/Experiential Education Director/Associate/Assistant Director at the first sign of difficulty so that problems can be addressed and resolved in a timely and professional manner.
