History of Present Illness

- Hazel is at home on home health care including OT/PT, outpatient pharmacy, home health nurse and providers
- Multiple hospital admissions over past 6 months (>1/month)
- Hazel is symptomatic during palliative care clinic visit; son is with her

Visit Summary: 80-yo female, presented to clinic with dyspnea, cough, and mild confusion. Discussed possible hospital admission. Patient indicated that hospitalization or acute rehab stay are not aligned with her wishes. She insists on being home, and wants to focus on comfort and quality of life rather than continuing hospital readmissions. Discussed hospice with Hazel and her son, Bradley. Both have agreed that hospice aligns with her wishes at this stage of her illness. Home hospice agency notified.

Current Symptoms:

- Activity intolerance (wheel chair, could not walk from chair to clinic door)

- Poor appetite
- o Insomnia/Fatigue
- o Confusion
