Qualifications for Mentors:

- Be in good academic standing
- 3.0 GPA or higher

Responsibilities of Mentors:

- Meet with mentee twice a month
- Attend monthly mentor/mentee meetings
- Attend monthly mentor workshops
- Attend the reception or celebration at the end of the year
- Work with mentee individually to help facilitate a smooth transition to university life
- Talk to mentee about educational strategies, goals, and opportunities
- Commit to mentoring for the entire school year
- Demonstrate active engagement at Creighton University
- Act with integrity, safety, honesty, responsibility, respect, and always maintain confidentiality

- Be a first year SSS student
- Possess a sincere desire to meet with a mentor

- Be flexible and willing to learn
