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In an effort to comply with accreditation and ongoing programmatic quality assurance, completion of all summative course/instructor evaluations is encouraged by all SPAHP students.

This policy recognizes that summative course/instructor evaluations are conducted in accordance with the School's Teaching Effectiveness Plan and may not be required with each offering of a given course. Course instructors should communicate clearly with enrolled students about the mechanisms being employed, the rationale to assess teaching and course effectiveness in a given semester, and the students' role in providing course assessment data.
