3D Scanning

3D scanners take snapshots of realworld objects, producing a 3D model that can be used for 3D printing.

Creighton students, faculty, and staff can check out a 3D scanner, for 4-hour in-library use at our Creation Stations, from the Reinert-Alumni Library Services Desk.

3D printers use digital models to create three-dimensional objects one layer at a time.

Creighton students, faculty, staff, and alumni can use the 3D service.

The cost for printing is \$.10 per gram of plastic filament and support used.

3D printing can be done anywhere! Try printing at home with one of our miniprinters.

Students, faculty, and staff are able to check out a 3D printer for 7 days. Special training must be completed and the

Library's equipment agreement form must be signed before printers can be checked out. The Library sells 100 grams of plastic filament to use with the printer for \$5.00.
